#### Recent Events: Acrylic Landscape Workshop

On 25 May 16 eager learners showed up at the Charles Morris Hall for an all-day workshop



with Jan Munro. Jan shared with us the techniques she uses to create her beautiful, atmospheric landscapes, characterised by skilful design and use of colour. This was a liberating event which showed us how to move away from an over-emphasis on detail. We created texture in the foreground, painted shapes via negative space and used colour layers to give the impression of receding distance. Jan's step-by-step method ensured we all achieved a satisfying result at the end of the day.

#### AGM - 1st May 2024

Thank you to all members who came to the AGM and social. In particular the committee appreciates contributions of ideas for the 2024/25 programme. It was a good occasion to catch up with members and discuss ideas for our activities. <u>The draft minutes are attached</u> <u>separately in this email.</u> The key outcomes of the meeting for members' attention are:

- The SAAS accounting year will be aligned with the annual membership start date and activity programme which will all now be in October
- Membership fees will remain the same for 2024/25 (Note: There is very likely to be an increase for 2025/26)
- New members joining after 1st April will pay a reduced fee of £15 for 1st April 2025 to Sept 2025 (not applicable to previous members)
- Emergency contact information will be collected from members when joining/renewing membership
- The SAAS Safeguarding Policy was adopted and will be published on the website.
- Minor updates/adjustments were agreed to the SAAS Rules (Constitution). These will now be published on the website.
- A new 2024 exhibition entry category (12" x 12" Panel) is available see exhibition info previously distributed/on website
- Honorary lifetime membership was given to Margaret Channon in appreciation of over 20 years' service to the SAAS committee.
